AHI USA wishes all the 2010 Yamaha Catalina WSB tournament anglers tight lines and good luck.

The all new Sabo Jig Head System is the latest creation from the Gardena-based AHI Usa. This all new performance tuned jig system has been developed with the Southern Californian angler in mind. Tournament anglers will find that the three Sabo head styles each have a specific application and purpose for fishing wsb.

The Sabo Squid Heads are a true squid imitator that offer realistic appearance and action fish can't resist. Drop the Sabo Squid down and watch it work. Pop the rod tip up for realistic jiggling action. Tuned action fins cause the lure to dodge and dart. The impact-resistant outer shell features amazing squidlike detail and vibrant

colors to suit a variety of baits and conditions.

The laser sharp point assures a solid hook set. The Squid Head works great with a squid or two pinned on it. Cast it out towards the kelp line and slowly work it back to the boat. The WSB simply can't resist! The glow Sabo Squid Head makes it a great option for fishing in the grey or dark or on the bait grounds. You can also fish the Sabo Squid head with hoochies, skirts and plastic squids.

Sabo Jig Heads are twice the size of a standard jig head without twice the weight! A larger head-per-weight ratio offers anglers a more uniform and natural look. Select the size that best fits your lure. Vibrant colors and

realistic features make the Sabo Jig Head a great option for fishing a variety of conditions.

WSB anglers will find the Sabo Jig Head a great option for fishing with their favorite swimbait. Extensive research and time on the water went into designing a jig head that swims and moves in an absolutely lifelike manner that prized fish such as the white sea bass inhale when given the opportunity. Cast it towards the kelp line, cove or rock structure, work it back to the boat and hold on tight.

The Sabo Bullet Heads are also larger than normal jig heads but without a noticeable weight increase. The Sabo Bullet Head comes standard in a potent glow color that make it stand out even in the toughest conditions. The laser sharp point ensures a solid hook up. WSB anglers will want to fish the glow-colored Sabo Bullet Head with a swimbait or scampi tail. Grey light or dark conditions would be a good time to cast this one out and twitch and retrieve it back to the boat. Don't be surprised if a tournament-winning white seabass decides to eat the Sabo Bullet Head the second it hits the water.

Using Dyneema fibers with their patented cold-fusion process, Ultracast is an amazingly strong, smooth, thin casting braid that is suited perfectly for anglers needing a braided line that will 'reach out' and make smooth and long casts possible.

Ultracast became the 'go to' braid for many freshwater bass pros when flipping and casting in heavy cover — so we decided to seed Ultracast with our saltwater guides and captains who run charters specifically for white sea bass.

Bob Hoose, saltwater field service manager reported, "I had our key charterboat and pro staff guys field test it. All these guys/gals loved its casting characteristics. It is a smooth user-friendly braid that allows anglers to fire jigs and baits into structure while targeting seabass and yellows along the kelp lines or even inside the kelp beds." For targeting white seabass and yellowtail — the pros recommend 50-pound and 6-pound moss green Ultracast tied to a

short fluorocarbon leader using a surgeon knot. Zane Stotesbury, one of their newest 'young guns' on the pro staff reported back with 'epic' results for both saltwater and Diamond Valley Lake casting applications. This type of crossover, being superior on both seabass/yellows and largemouth was exactly what the engineers were hoping for, and they got it.

Along with its casting advantage, Ultracast has a unique braid construction and special additives for lubrication that makes this braided line an inshore saltwater favorite. Both knot and breaking strength were 24 percent and 17 percent stronger than the competition.

Hoose added, "Ultracast should not be used as backing because this braid likes to fly off the reel! Ultracast is a performance braid, and anglers needing a 'stealth rig' to muscle a big 'ghost' out of the kelp during the WON white seabass tournament will not be disappointed performance-wise. Jimmy Decker likes to fish 65-pound Ultracast when yo-yoing a Salas Christy II for seabass or put the 65-pound moss green Ultracast on a 'stealth rig' and fire away..."
